# ITINERARY

## DAY 1: WELCOME TO CHILE

**TUE 29 AUG**

Own flight arrangements to arrive in Santiago, the capital of Chile. Home to 40% of the country's population, Santiago is a large city situated in a valley surrounded by the snow-capped Andes Mountains and the coast. Own flight arrangements to connect with a late afternoon flight of 70 minutes to Valdivia in the green south of Chile. Meet for dinner at your hotel this evening where you will be introduced to the Chilean national drink - the famous pisco sour.

**Overnight: Valdivia / Meals: - - D**

## DAY 2: VALDIVIA

**WED 30 AUG**

Start the day at the Austral University, visiting with the Institute for Food Sciences and Technology where a research team is developing winter feed for bees. Next visit the local fish market, where the enormous sea lions come right up to the riverside steps for hand-outs. Afterwards travel to the nearby ocean-side town of Niebla for a fresh fish lunch and a meeting with ApiVet which provides consulting and educational training services, to see how they are helping to organise the beekeepers of the region. Return to Valdivia in the evening.

**Overnight: Valdivia / Meals: B L D**

## DAY 3: VALDIVIA - OSORNO

**THU 31 AUG**

Morning visit with the regional Ministry of Agriculture offices for an introduction and overview of apiculture in Chile plus information on governmental projections and developmental assistance. Next, head inland for a visit with Apicoop, a co-operative of beekeepers which has set up their own processing plant. Later, travel south to the agricultural services centre city of Osorno, located in the region of Los Lagos (the lakes) in south central Chile. The Los Lagos region marks the start of the beginning of the stunning Patagonia region which extends down to the far south of Chile and Argentina.

## DAY 4: OSORNO - LLANQUIHUE

**FRI 1 SEP**

Today there may be a visit the AutoMuseum Moncopulli (moncopulli.cl), an impressive private vehicle museum, located on a dairy farm. Travel south for lunch on a dairy farm with the 4th-generation owners. Weather permitting, there will be time for a walk-about to see how dairy farming

differs from what happens in Australia. Continue travelling south for an afternoon arrival in the lakeside resort town of Puerto Varas, with a stop en route at a business which deals with a wide range of beekeeping and processing equipment. Travel to Llanquihue on the western shore of Lake Llanquihue, seven kilometres north of Puerto Varas.

**Overnight: Llanquihue / Meals: B L D**

## DAY 5: LLANQUIHUE

**SAT 2 SEP**

Today there's a full day excursion into the Andes Mountains with a visit to a professional beekeeper to see his apiculture operations and his products (honey, cosmetics and therapy). Relax over lunch on the shores of an Andean fjord lake. Afterwards, depending on the interests of the group, stop at a Jersey dairy which makes and sells their own 'dulce de leche'; sweetened caramelised milk that's traditionally used in desserts. Saturday night is free to enjoy the lively cafe and pub scene - with the casino just next door.

**Overnight: Three Valley Gap / Meals: B L -**

## DAY 6: LLANQUIHUE - PUERTO MONTT - SANTIAGO

**SUN 3 SEP**

Morning excursion to Puerto Montt, a sea port known as a gateway to the Andes mountains and the Patagonian fjords. Puerto Montt is a regional capital city which sits on an arm of the Pacific Ocean. Enjoy a steamed shellfish and pork rib lunch overlooking the sea before transferring to the local airport for the 90 minute flight back to Santiago (own flight arrangements at an additional cost). On arrival, transfer to the Hotel Four Points in the mixed residential-commercial district of Providencia, where you will stay for the six nights of the Apimondia Conference. Evening free.

## DAY 7: APIMONDIA 2023

**MON 4 SEP**

Apimondia - the 48th International Apicultural Congress 2023 commences today. Transfer the seven km to Espacio Riesco, the venue for the congress, in time for registration and the opening ceremony. There will be transfers available back to the hotel at mid-day and in the afternoon following the end of the day's program.

## DAY 8 to DAY 11: APIMONDIA 2023

**TUE 5 SEP TO FRI 8 SEP**

Apimondia 2023 is focussed on sustainable beekeeping from the south of the world and will have a series of international scientific presentations and round tables with specific topics designed and presented by worldwide recognised specialists. Technical tours will take you to nearby beekeeping operations and provide the chance to visit world class bodegas to taste Chilean wines. During the Apimondia Congress you can meet old friends and make new ones as you tour the ApiEXPO trade exhibition and take in the latest science and beekeeping ideas. During the Apimondia Congress there will be daily transfers to the conference venue each morning, at mid-day and in the afternoon following the end of the day's program.

## DAY 12: CHILE TO ARGENTINA

**SAT 9 SEP**

Check-out of the hotel and transfer to the international airport for onward travel to Buenos Aires (own flight arrangements at an additional cost). You will be met at Buenos Aires Airport and transferred to your hotel. Buenos Aires, the capital city of Argentina, has a total population (including the suburbs) of 14 million, and is one of the largest cities in the world. Around one third of the total population of Argentina lives in this city.

**Overnight: Buenos Aires / Meals: B - D**

## DAY 13: BUENOS AIRES

**SUN 10 SEP**

Depart for a morning guided sightseeing tour of Buenos Aires visiting all the major historic sights, the well preserved colonial area and the famous colourful neighbourhood of La Boca. The afternoon is free to explore on your own. This evening, transfer for dinner and a spectacular Tango show to see expert dancers executing their dance steps. Tango derived from a mixture of European and African music and was born in the port area of Buenos Aires and initially was only danced in port bars and warehouses and other places of ill repute.

## DAYS 14: BUENOS AIRES - GUALEGUAYCHÚ

**MON 11 SEP**

Morning visit to the Argentinean Cooperative Association

(ACA) the biggest export company in the country. Argentina has a long history of co-operatives dating back to the last years of the 19th century. They were originally linked to the massive influx of European immigrants and contributed with not only techniques and work procedures, but also traditions and mutual forms of organisation that introduced ideas of solidarity and cooperation through institutions in which they were grouped by nationality, community, religion, social class, job or activity. These cooperative experiences brought by European immigrants were the basis of the future mutuals, cooperatives, development societies and unions that were created in the country in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. The first agricultural cooperatives date from this time. Next visit an organisation for a presentation on the local market and foreign trade, then travel on to Gualeguaychú, a city in eastern Argentina near the border with Uruguay.

**Overnight: Gualeguaychú / Meals: B L D**

## DAY 15: GUALEGUAYCHÚ

**TUE 12 SEP**

Today there will be a number of farm visits, including bee-keeping co-operatives, where you will have an opportunity to meet with bee-keepers for discussions on the state of the apiculture industry in Argentina.

**Overnight: Gualeguaychú / Meals: B L D**

## DAY 16: GUALEGUAYCHÚ - BUENOS AIRES

**WED 13 SEP**

Depart from Gualeguaychú for Buenos Aires with an apiary visit en route on the delta of the Paraná River. At 4,880 kilometres long and second in length to the Amazon, the Parana River runs through Brazil, Paraguay and Argentina and is a major river for the transportation of grain and other commodities.

**Overnight: Buenos Aires / Meals: B L D**

## DAY 17: TOUR ENDS

**THU 14 SEP**

The tour ends today. Make your own way to the airport for the return flight to Australia. Alternatively, why not spend a little more time in South America? Our team can help with onward travel arrangements.
